Rooted is an inclusive group, full of exciting outdoor learning activities and social opportunities, focused on the needs of disabled children aged 8 – 16. Led by a qualified and experienced teacher, the sessions which are jointly planned with the young people attending incorporate cooking, gardening, crafts and other social activities.

Siblings are very welcome.

Every Monday 4pm - 6pm (term time).

Every Saturday (all year unless notified).

Younger Group 10am - 12:30pm.

Older Group (12+) 12:00 am - 2:30pm.

Fees are £5 for first or only child and £3 for each additional sibling, paid on attendance.
